## This funding will be used to:

- ensure students who are below benchmarks will be targeted to ensure they achieve school benchmarks, receive A-C across all learning areas, and meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- employ staff to assist in the collection of student data
- employ staff to work with identified students to achieve school benchmarks.

Our goals for 2018 include:

- 100% of students achieve internal diagnostic goals
- 100% of students achieve NMS in NAPLAN for reading and writing and numeracy
- 100% of students achieve A-C results.

## Our initiatives include:

- implementing intervention programs for identified students by teaching staff and teacher aides. with extra teacher aide hours used to provide one on one support for identified students
- improving the knowledge of teachers and teacher aides in regards to pedagogy, curriculum and classroom management
- using our five week data review cycle to highlight the areas that need greater focus to reach school and ILP goals.
